## **ESSAY CONTEST**

## "WHAT DOES BEING A VETERAN MEAN TO ME?"

- 1. This year's Essay Contest topic/title is: "WHAT DOES BEING A VETERAN MEAN TO ME?"
- 2. Any student enrolled in grades 6 through 8 in a public, private or parochial school or who is home schooled in Pennsylvania is eligible to participate.
- 3. All essays MUST have a cover page containing the following information:
  - Essay topic/title
  - Name, address, telephone, & email address (if applicable) of contestant.
  - Sponsoring American Legion Post number, name & location.
  - Parent or guardian name.
- 4. The topic/title MUST appear on page one (1) of the essay, as well as the cover page.
- 5. ALL essays MUST be no less than 500 words and no more than 1,000 words.
- 6. Typewritten essays are preferred but not required.
- 7. Essays shall be judged on the following:
  - Proper English structure.
  - Accuracy.
  - > Extent of information
  - > Originality Any material not original must be cited in a bibliography for the information of the judges, stating publication, volume, page, date, publisher and author.
- 8. Students MUST certify that essays are prepared without assistance other than that provided for all members of their class.
- 9. The PA essay program, as any program conducted by The American Legion, is designed to provide balanced judging. It is suggested that at least three (3) qualified judges be used.
- 10. The "**local school**" must determine its own winner and submit the winning essay to the sponsoring or American Legion Post immediately for judging.
