GENERAL COURSE --provides information on all Department programs, activities and membership.

AUXILIARY CLASS-- is an all-day class that covers issues pertaining to the Auxiliary.

SAL COURSE --is a course for the Sons of The American Legion.

EAST--(The first half of the day will be spent in the General Course and from noon on will go to the SAL course.)

WEST—(The first half of the day will be spent in the SAL Course and from noon on will go to the General course.)

SERVICE OFFICER COURSE-- is an all-day class that will give insight on filing claims and assisting veterans in need.

HOME ASSOCIATION COURSE -- is an all-day course that will educate attendees on bookkeeping, IRS, 990 & other forms, small games of chance and the Home Association's relationship to the Post.

LEGION RIDERS COURSE-- is a class, learning about the different aspects of the Legion Riders. *(The first half of the day will be spent in the General Course and from noon on will go to the riders course.)*

CHAPLAIN COURSE-- is for those who are or may want to become a Chaplain and will explain your obligations and duties within your Post as the Chaplain. *(The first half of the day will be spent in the General Course, and from noon on will go to the chaplain course.)*
