- A. Submissions are in effect the Post's scrapbook of its efforts during the past year.
- B. Clippings may be submitted from any newspaper mentioning the Post (by name or number).
- C. Department's "Keystone News" and the Post's own publication do not qualify. Other organization publications, such as school news, do not qualify.
- D. All clippings must be identified with the newspaper name and date of publication.
- E. Be sure the following are included:

clippings, presented in the manner set forth in the rules, are attached.

- 1. Photo clips may be included when it is clearly indicated that the Legion is involved, either by use of a Legion backdrop or by at least one individual pictured wearing his/her Legion cap.
- 2. Only joint Legion and Auxiliary or joint SAL and Legion news is acceptable.
- 3. Public service announcements, such as Veterans Day, Memorial Day, etc., will be credited if sponsored in whole or part by the Post.

F. DO NOT INCLUDE

- 1. Auxiliary or SAL news alone.
- 2. District, Department or National news unless the Post has taken the initiative to add something of local interest.
- 3. Advertisements for bingo, fundraisers, etc. (unless benefiting charitable or community causes).

G. Organizing Material

- 1. Clippings must be mounted on paper of uniform size.
- 2. The pages of paper must be stapled or otherwise fastened together (although a fancy scrapbook is not necessary, it is acceptable).
- 3. This form must be completed and attached as the first page of the submission.
- 4. Digital form (thumb drive, etc.) will be accepted with pictures, links and description of articles. Contents must meet with the above criteria.
